The Farmers Club of Baldwin County was founded by William McKinley, J. B. Gonder, A. I. Butts, J. S. Thomas, L. Carrington, and R. N. Lamar on Aug. 5, 1871.

"Resolved, that in the judgment of this meeting, it is very important and useful to the farmers, householders, and staple trade merchants of Baldwin County, to organize as a Farmers Club." (Southern Recorder)

The Farmers Club of Baldwin County was the precursor to the Progressive Farmers Club of Baldwin County.

Scope and Contents note

Meeting minutes constitute the majority of the collection. Ranging from the late 20's to the early 2000's, the PFC shows us a look inside the club's structure.
